a partnership with the Springboard for the Arts and Neighborhood Involvement Program

The Twin Cities Musicians Union Access to Healthcare (TCMU AH) program is a partnership with the Artists' Access to Healthcare program sponsored by the Springboard for the Arts. This program is designed to meet the needs of metropolitan area musicians in our Local who are in need of healthcare. TCMU AH vouchers for healthcare are provided to those who show membership in this local, verify that they play music professionally, and are either without health insurance or underinsured for health insurance. Through this application, qualifying musicians will receive a healthcare voucher in the amount of \$40 one time per year to be used at the N.I.P. Community Clinic at 2431 Hennepin Ave. S., Minneapolis, MN 55405. This voucher will pay the expense of a basic examination.

The application should be submitted to Springboard for the Arts, 308 Prince Street, #270, Saint Paul, MN 55101. Musicians can expect to know if they are eligible for the voucher within 48 hours of the application, and the voucher will be ready the same day the application is approved.
